A World Communion Experience



Cross describe their year-long trip to Scotland

Trinity Parish recently celebrated an unusual World Communion service at the Mission Creek Presbyterian Church, Liberty.

Invited to spend a year in Scotland, Sylva and Gail Cross Rev. Gail and Sylvia presented lessons based on their observations of three churches. During their trip, Gail served two churches in Perth as associate pastor. These Church of Scotland congregations reflected the traditions of John Knox, the great reformer and founder of Presbyterianism in Scotland. The third "church"

was an ancient site on the island of Iona. They visited the Abbey of Iona of the Iona Community which provides an ecumenical opportunity for inspiration and meditation. Gail and Sylvia offered fascinating insights from their spiritual journey and ministry with congregations of "cousin" Presbyterians.

Communion was a moving experience of the "Bread Body" of Christ. This stark portrayal was brought back from a mission trip sponsored by the Beatrice Presbyterian Church youth group, with whom Trinity Parish youth have often Elders arranged loaves of bread on the communion table, then covered the loaves with a sheet to reveal the shape of a draped body. A reading reminded the congregation of Jesus' words to "Take and eat."


