New 1001 Worship Community Opens In Lincoln

HeBrews 211 is opening at First Pres (Lincoln) this month. Several months ago a renovation project began at First to rews and a space to launch a new worshiping community (1001:10) to specifically reach the 20-somethins/young

Lenten Studies from the Resource Center

We have hardly finished celebrating Christmas and Epiphany and already we must ready our hearts and minds for the season of Lent. I would like to invite you to join others this season in a journey with Christ to the cross and beyond to resurrection. Whether you are interested in the events of Jesus life; particularly Holy Week or simply want to deepen your own spiritual life and understanding, the Resource Center for Churches has a study just for you.

Adam Hamilton's studies for Lent are among the favorites at the Resource Center. "Final Words From the Cross" is a seven session study by Hamilton that gives us fresh insights into the perspective of those who witnessed the crucifixion. The sessions are 1) Father, Forgive Them 2) Today You Will Be With Me in Paradise 3) Behold Your Son...Behold Your Mother 4) My God, My God, Why Have You Forsaken Me 5) I Thirst 6) It Is Finished 7) The Words After That. This seventh session moves us forward with the disciples who witness the Resurrection and walked with Jesus on the Emmaus road. The book and leader's guide are included.

If you have not used Hamilton's Lenten study "24 Hours That Changed the World," I would highly recommend it for your small study group or for a church wide study. Not only will you travel to the Holy Land and visit the sites where the events of Holy Week happened, but you gain new understanding of the events and **Homestead Presbytery**
