In the article in the March 31 of The Homesteader, I attempted to clarify some questions concerning the affect of the new wording in our Book of Order concerning the definition of marriage and its affect on Teaching Elder (Pastor) ordination vows.

I hope these remarks may provide additional clarity:

- 1. The Directory for Worship is not a confession that we need to either subscribe to or be guided in faith by.
- 2. One who is ordained may disagree with the definition of marriage used in the W-4.9001, and continue to have the liberty to exercise his/her faith convictions. This freedom of conscience is specifically protected.
- conform our actions, not our beliefs.
- 4. To abide by our church's discipline is to conform to the Rules of Discipline.
- 5. To be governed by our church polity does not in any way constrain belief of marriage being between a woman and a man.
- I appreciate the confusion that has arisen since the approval of the change in W-4.9001 and hope that I have in some way helped so that you can better understand and explain the situation. Grace and Peace.
