

2018 Robert Giles Outstanding Homesteader

Congratulations to Frances McIntosh, 93, of Fourth Presbyterian Church in Lincoln! Frances was awarded the 2018 Robert Giles Outstanding Homesteader Award. This award honors clergy and laity in the Presbytery who have made outstanding contributions to church and community life. Frances joined Fourth Presbyterian church in 1944 and was ordained as one of the first female Elders in 1967. She was faithfully married to Wayne for 52 years until his passing. She has two children, Joanne, who works in an assisted living center

and Dan, a Lincoln firefighter.

Frances has been actively involved in the church since she joined. She accompanied worship on the piano for over 30 years, serves as our financial contributions secretary and is currently a contributing member of the church mission & outreach committee. She has served on every church committee throughout the years and still teaches Adult Sunday School after more than 40 years.

Frances has also been active outside of her local congregation. She worked with Presbyterian Women at both Presbytery and Synod level and served as President of the Women of Nebraska City Presbytery. Frances was instrumental in helping reorganize PW when we became Homestead Presbytery and served as treasurer and secretary for over a decade.

Frances is a strong proponent of ecumenical outreach and has served on the board of Church Women United of Lincoln through which she was awarded the Valiant Woman Award as well as still being a regular attendee. She is also extremely active in the community and currently serves as a member of the Women's Wesleyan Educational Council (WWEC).

Finally, Frances is still an avid bowler who bowls twice a week!
