"The 224th General Assembly referred all items of business which had constitutional implications to the 225th gathering," said Laurie Griffith, associate director for Constitutional Interpretation in the Office of the General Assembly. "That means there were no changes to the Book of Order and the current edition is effective through 2023." Griffith says this is a first in the PC(USA).
