IMPORTANT PRESBYTERY REMINDERS!

ATTENTION!!

According to the Manual of the COM, the following people are **REQUIRED** to complete Boundary Training:

"All Ministers of Word and Sacrament who are members of Homestead Presbytery; Minister of Word and Sacrament serving in any capacity within the bounds of Homestead Presbytery; minister of another denomination serving under the authority of Homestead Presbytery; commissioned pastor; and certified Christian Educator are required to complete Presbytery sponsored boundary training. Also: all persons (lay or ordained) on the Pulpit Supply List; members of the Commission on Ministry or any other committee or commission in Homestead Presbytery; and all commissioners elected to Synod or General Assembly are to complete this training. (Any requests for exception to this requirement should be directed to COM.)"

APOLLOS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 15

Eligibility Requirements:

An Apollos applicant must be:

- 1. An individual who possesses qualities of excellence for ministry
- 2. A member of a Presbyterian Church (USA) congregation
- 3. Currently under the care of a Presbytery as an Inquirer or a Candidate
- 4. Accepted or enrolled as a full-time student in the Master of Divinity, Master of Arts or Dual degree program in one of the 10 Presbyterian seminaries.

Application Process and Requirements

The Apollos application instructions must be followed in their entirety.

A complete application consists of the following components:

- 1. A completed five-page application.
- 2. An official transcript of records from universities where his/her degree(s) are conferred.

Each transcript should be in an official sealed envelope from the registrar's office. We can also accept transcripts from universities via electronic services, email or fax. We can NOT accept transcripts sent to us directly by seminary students.

- 3. An official transcript of seminary records if currently enrolled. The transcript should be in a sealed envelope from the registrar's office. We can also accept transcripts from seminaries via electronic services, email or fax.
- 4. Three non-family references on the required Reference Questionnaire forms in sealed envelopes.
